

RULEBOOK – PRAGUE GAMES

The tournament is played by valid international IFF rules with exceptions specified in this document.

<u>Team list</u>

- Each club is obligated to fill in online **team list for each team before the first day of the tournament.** Only players included on this list can participate in the tournament.
- There is no possibility to change the list after the tournament start.
- Players with granted age exceptions will be assigned to team list by the organiser.

Number of players for category U10

- Category is played 3+1 system.
- Minimal number of players of a team is 5.

Match protocol

- Designated team leader must fill and confirm electronical match protocol for each game at latest 30 minutes before the scheduled match start.
- Instructions regarding the electronical match protocol are available <u>here</u>.

Age rule exceptions

- An exception can be granted to players, **who are maximal one year older** than the limit for give category.
- Player granted with exception can play only in the one team the exception is granted for.
- In boys' categories there can be maximal number of players with granted exception on a team list is three. But only one of them can participate in a match. In girls' categories the maximal number of players with granted exception on a team list is three. But only two of them can participate in a match.
- An exception is charged **40 EUR**. The fee can be in justified cases excused (e.g. when a team has no team in category the player can participate without any exception.)
- All request for an age exception must be sent by June 15th in the Club Zone. The organiser considers all requests within 10 days from submission date.
- Exception is granted by decision of tournament jury.
- There are not age exceptions in category U10.

Players' allowance

- A player can play for one and only team in given category.
- It is allowed to play within a single club in two or more different categories if the player is eligible for the age restrictions for each category.
- If a player is granted an exception, he or she can play only for the one team, for which the exception was granted.
- Girls can participate in boys' categories without any limitations while they meet the



age restriction criteria for these categories. Number of girls on the team players list is unlimited.

Identity check

- **Team is obligated to proof the identity of a team member** by suitable ID, which can determine the player's age.
- The opponent may ask for the check no longer than by the end of the first break between first and second period using the protest option.
- In case of unauthorized player's start, the protest will be proceeded to the jury, who will decide about further penalty.

<u>Protest</u>

- A protest must be in written form, addressed to the jury, turned in hall supervisor's hands at latest 15 minutes after the disputed match including payment of the protest fee.
- Protest fee is **40 EUR**. In case of justified protest, the fee will be full refunded. In the other case, the fee is forfeited.
- Jury decision is ultimate and irreversible.

Referees

- Matches are conducted by licensed referees from Czech Floorball or any other IFF member federation.
- Matches of category U10 are conducted by one referee only.

Playground dimensions

- Matches are played on standardised playground according to floorball rules.
- Categories B12 and G12 use cage lowering devices.
- Category **U10** plays on reduced playground with **dimensions 21 m x 12 m**.
- Category U10 uses reduced cages suitable for the category with dimensions 120 cm x 90 cm.

Walk over

- Waiting time is 5 minutes. After that period the late team will lose with score 0:5.
- Team whose **two matches are lost by default because of late arrival**, will be **excluded from the tournament** and its results will be invalidated.

Dressing rooms

- Dressing rooms are used as walk through.
- After changing it is necessary to take all your belongings with you out of the room.
- The organiser is not responsible for any loss of personal belongings.



<u>Warm up</u>

- It is not possible to warm up on the field before the game.
- Warm up is possible only off the court in area that is suitable for that.

Jersey colours

• In case of mistakable jersey colours **the away team must change** into different colours.

Game time

- For group games and games up to the level of 1/8 finals included the game time is 2 x 15 minutes.
- All game time is **non-effective**. Break between periods is 2 minutes.
- In all quarterfinals, semifinals, and final games the game time is 2 x 20 minutes with 3 last minutes of the second period measured effectively.
- **Mercy rule:** if the difference of current score is 10 or more, the time is stopped on the referees request only.
- Time out is available from quarterfinals.
- For category **U10 are exceptional rules applied**:
 - Game time is **2 x 7 minutes** (can be adjusted according to final number of participating teams).
 - Time is **non-effective** for all game. Break time is 1 minute.
 - **Time out is not available** at all.

Penalty cards

- Red card 1 leads to ejection for the rest of given game.
- Red card 2 leads to ejection for the next game and to summoning of Jury to decide about further penalty for the player. In extreme cases the player can be excluded from the tournament.

Group qualification key

- Victory gives 3 points; tie gives 1 point and loss gives 0 points.
- In case of **two or more teams** with same number of points the order is determined by following rules:
 - 1. Number of points from mutual games *
 - 2. Score difference from mutual games *
 - 3. Total number of scored goals from mutual games *
 - 4. Total score difference
 - 5. Total number of scored goals
 - 6. Draw

(*) Mutual games are meant only matches of team with the same number of points. Results from games with other teams are not considered for this evaluation. Relative standing between same number of points teams is determined. In this order are these teams put back



into the whole group table.

Play-off qualification key

- In case of tie in a play-off game, follows:
 - 1. series of **3 penalty shots**
 - 2. series of 1 penalty shot (sudden death)
