



Rules and regulations for Gävle Bågskytteklubb

- Never put an arrow on the string if someone is in front of the shooting line.
- Only draw the bow, with or without an arrow, when you are standing on the shooting line and have the arrow pointed at the target. (you must not draw the bow aiming above the target)
- Never shoot an arrow straight up into the air.
- The shooter is always responsible for ensuring that no one is behind or in front of the target.
- No one under the age of 18 may practice alone on the shooting range.
- All members must be treated with respect.
- Do not shoot more than three arrows per round to avoid making people wait.
- Using alcohol in connection with training or competition is strictly prohibited.
- Please note that no one is standing behind you when you pull the arrows out of the target board, as someone could be injured by getting the back of the arrow in the face.
- When looking for an arrow, the bow should be placed leaning against the target so that those coming behind can see that you are there.

I have taken note of these rules and safety regulations and understood their meaning.
