
# Getting to know your NAUCON-1000



# 1 On/off

Turn the NAUCON-1000 on and off. When turning off the control panel you must confirm by pressing ACCEPT on the touch screen.

#### **2** Game reset

Reset display, you must confirm by pressing **ACCEPT** on the touch screen.

- 3 Menu




Fig. 1 – Select sport

  - A menu on the touch screen will show (Fig. 1, page 6).
- 4 Setup

A menu on the touch screen will show.

**5** Manual horn

Press to blow the horn.

**6** Time reset

Resets time and sets next period time. You must confirm by pressing ACCEPT on the touch screen.

**2** Start

Game clock starts.

8 Stop

Game clock stops.

9 Undo

Undo the latest change.

**1** OK

Confirm any changes made to the setup.



# Indicator icons

THE INDICATOR ICONS will show in the top right corner of the touch screen. Except in the setup menus.









Battery charging

**Battery low**

(BATTERYLOW!) Battery critically low – charge now!

All zones active

All zones disabled

Zone 1-4

COLLISION – another NAUCON-1000 is transmitting in the same zone.

\*Change or disable zones. See more on page 7.

\*Note you might see the flashing collision warning even when all zones are turned off.

# Start setting up your NAUCON-1000

When starting your NAUCON-1000 it will start up in a default sport. If setting up for the first time the NAUCON-1000 will start in basketball. To exit the sport press the MENU click button on the console and then press **EXIT SPORT.**

# Select sport

The choices of sports are listed in a menu – to scroll the menu press PAGE 1/3 MORE. Choose a sport and you are ready to start/setting up.

#### 2 Version ...

Shows the latest version of software installed on the NAUCON-1000 unit.

## A General setup

Enter GENERAL SETUP menu. For details see the section, starting below.

## B Page 1/3 more

Press PAGE 1/3 MORE to scroll the pages in the menu.

# General setup

In this part of the manual you can learn more about the general setup of your NAU-CON-1000. You can enter the GENERAL SETUP menu from the SELECT SPORT menu.




Fig. 2 – General setup menu, page 1/2. The bottom buttons are elaborated on the next page.

# Fig. 2 – General setup "Page 1/2":

## **1** Date, year and time of day

You can change the day, month, year and time of day. Once set, the NAUCON-1000 unit will transmit the changes to the Scoreboard. It will now receive time, date and year information from the main scoreboard. The NAUCON-1000 does not have a built-in timer.

## 2 Language

Scroll through the various languages.

# 3 Start-up sport

Set the default START-UP SPORT.

# **4** Text flow direction

Adjust the direction of the rolling text line. LEFT or RIGHT.

### 5 Board zone selection menu

Turns the zones ON and OFF. As default, all zones are on. If another NAU-CON-1000 are transmitting in the same zone, they might interfere.

## 6 Board info

The NAUCON-1000 starts searching for scoreboards in the activated zones.

- → If a scoreboard is turned on and connected to the NAUCON-1000, the addresse\*1 from the scoreboard, sideboard, sideboard or shot clocks are displayed on the touch screen.
- \*1An address is a reference number (10-69) in the BOARD ZONES SETUP menu, see page 14.




Fig. 3 – General setup menu, page 2/2

# **☑** Board watch – on and off time

By default the clock on the board will start up at 07:00 and turn off again at midnight. You can change both settings.

Set the clock to be on **or** off at all time:

00:00-24:00: The clock is always on. 00:00-00:00: The clock is always off.

## 8 Key click

Turn ON or OFF a sound for the buttons on the touch screen or/and the physical click buttons on the console.

## Backlight level

Adjusts the light intensity of the touch screen. 1 is lowest and 5 is highest intensity. Lower level will extend the battery performance.

## Dimming timeout after keypress

Time before dimming the backlight on the touch screen (0-99 min.).

## Dim backlight during game

Adjusts the light intensity of the touch screen during the game (0-99% of the backlight level).

#### Fig. 3 and 4 – Bottom buttons:

## A Cancel changes

Exists the setup menu without saving any changes made. A warning will appear before existing to the previous screen.

#### Service menu

Enter the **SERVICE MENU**.

→ Please ask your local sales partner for a password to enter this menu.

# • Page (1/2) 2/2 more

Press PAGE (1/2) 2/2 MORE to scroll the pages in the menu.

# • Default settings

Press **DEFAULT SETTINGS** if you want to return to the NAUCON-1000's default settings.

# • Accept changes

Press ACCEPT changes if you want to save your changes. You will then return to the **SELECT SPORT** menu.

# Floorball setup




Fig. 19a - Setup Floorball "Page 1/2"

Choose FLOORBALL from the SELECT SPORT MENU. Then press the **SETUP** click button on the console and you will see a menu like shown below, Fig. 19a.

# Fig. 19a - "Page 1/2":

## • Edit lineups

Choose either to edit HOME or GUEST team lineup. You will enter a screen where you can change the names and numbers of the players, see page 40.

#### 2 Period time

Sets the length of a period. Default is 20 minutes.

#### 3 Break time

Sets the length of the breaks between periods. Default is 10 minutes.

## 4 Pre time

Sets the length of the pre time / the time counting down before the match. Default is 0 minutes

# **5** Extended period time

Sets the length of an extended period. Default is 5 minutes.

#### **6** Count mode

Sets game clock to count DOWN or count UP. Default is UP.




Fig. 19b - Setup Floorball "Page 2/2"

### **⊘** Automatic horn

Turns the automatic horn ON or OFF. Default is ON.

# **3** Player number selection

Choose whether scores and penalties are given to a specific player or to the whole team. Default is TYPE.

LIST: Choose player number from a list.

TYPE: Type player number. OFF: Scores and penalties are given to the whole team

## Max concurrent penalties

Sets the max of penalties (1-5). Default: 2.

#### Show sideboards

Turns the sideboards ON or OFF. Default is ON.

## Periods

Sets the number of periods in the match. Default is 3.
