

Parent Meeting H3 – Summary, August 26, 2026

We currently have vacant positions within the team staff that need to be filled as soon as possible. These include the role of treasurer and 1–2 additional people for the sales group. If anyone feels they are able to help with these tasks, please contact team manager **Linnea Kax** as soon as possible, thank you.

Much of the information sent out to parents is communicated through the Facebook group “**KAIS Mora H3 föräldragrupp**”, so please make sure you are a member there.

The boys also have a Messenger group where the staff communicates with them. Please check that your child is included in that group. If not, they can ask **August** to add them. The Messenger group is called “**Kais h3 arbetsgrupp**”.

*Team Fund – How does it work?

It was decided that each player contributes **325 SEK per month**. You may choose whether you want to cover this amount by participating in sales activities (all profit from sales goes directly to the individual player) or if you prefer to pay out of pocket.

The amount should be swished to the treasurer (07x-xxx xxx x, mark the payment with “*player’s name KAIS H3*”) between the **25th and the last day of each month**. This will be reported monthly so we have a clear picture of the financial situation. Based on that, we can evaluate whether the monthly amount can be adjusted or if payments can be paused entirely.

*Large Bus – Sundsvall and Uppsala

The coaches would like the boys to travel by large bus to both **Uppsala in January** and **Sundsvall in February**. Last season, the bus to Sundsvall cost approximately **10,000 SEK**, and we can expect a similar price this year. The trip to Uppsala will be somewhat cheaper due to the shorter distance, but the total cost for both trips will be just under **20,000 SEK**.

There will likely be space for parents who wish to join these trips. The exact cost for accompanying parents has not yet been determined.

*Extra Car for Away Games

There may be occasions during the season when parents need to help with transportation or drive their own car to matches. Therefore, just like last year, we will

create an editable Excel file where everyone can fill in which matches they are able to assist with.

Please pay attention if a match is rescheduled — the parent who signed up for that match will follow the match to its new date. The link to the file will be posted in the parents' Facebook group once all schedule changes are finalized.

August believes most matches will be manageable without parent help, but it varies from game to game. Please consider your sign-up as a form of on-call duty — a slot where you may need to step in if one of the regular drivers (the coaches) is unavailable.

Please sign up for the matches where you are able to help.

No mileage compensation will be paid from the team fund.

***Season Budget**

Here is a rough estimate of the expected costs for this season:

- **20,000 SEK** – Bus trips to Uppsala and Sundsvall
- **6,000 SEK** – Activity for the end-of-season event
- **6,000 SEK** – Rental of minibus for schedule conflicts/rescheduled matches

***Sales Activities**

Last season we completed three sales activities in addition to the Christmas bingo lottery sales: **Ullmax**, **Newbody**, and **Klubbrabatten** coupon booklets. If anyone has suggestions for good products to sell, please contact team manager Linnea or sales coordinator Emma.

More information about upcoming sales activities will be shared in the parents' Facebook group.

This year, the club has decided to replace the sale of Bingo Christmas calendars and Sverigelotter with **toilet paper sales**. Each bale contains **32 rolls**, brand **Belinno**.

Each player must either:

- Sell **5 bales of toilet paper** at **250 SEK each**, or
- Pay **500 SEK** to the club to “opt out”.

Please inform **Emma Fanqvist** as soon as possible how you wish to proceed.

***Other Questions & Information**

-Bingolotter för christmas (Swedish charity bingo tickets)

Anyone who wants to sell bingo tickets must notify the sales group — currently **Emma Fanqvist** — no later than mid-October. Please specify how many tickets you want and which type (single, double, or triple). The club office places the order at the end of October, so it is important that we have your requests in time.

Profit from sales goes directly to the player, and as in previous years, unsold tickets may be returned.
